

South Course

Drop Zone #5 – The drop zone is immediately to the right of the cart path after your cross the ditch in the general area by the red stake. Drop your ball within two club lengths from the red stake in the general area no closer to the hole.

Options if your ball ends up in penalty area (ditch) defined by red stakes after your tee shot:

- You can play the ball as it lies in a penalty area.

When it is known or virtually certain that a ball is in a red penalty area and the player wishes to take relief, the player has four options (including one option which is a local rule for Antelope Hills Golfing Gals), each for a one penalty stroke. The player may:

1. Take stroke and distance relief by playing a ball from a relief area based on where the previous stroke was made, e.g., tee box
2. Take back-on-the-line relief by dropping a ball outside the penalty area, keeping the point where the ball crossed the ditch between the hole and point where the ball is dropped.
3. Take lateral relief (red penalty area only). The reference point for taking relief is where the ball crossed the penalty area and must be dropped in and played from the two-club length area, which is no nearer to the hole.
4. Dropping a ball in a defined drop area on the other side of the ditch by the red stake.

This local rule is effective January 5, 2026.

Note: Per Antelope Hills Golf Course – Local Rules:

- Drop Zone #8 North
 - Tee shot into the water hazard, may drop in zone between the willow tree and the cart path with a one stroke penalty.
