

Code of Conduct

Any of the following actions by members of the AHGG during any AHGG affiliated event constitutes a violation of the Code of Conduct. Any member who fails to comply with the Code of Conduct, will be subject to disciplinary action laid out by the AHGG Board in the AHGG Standing Rules.

- Verbal abuse, physical abuse, or legitimate threats of abuse toward fellow players, competitors, guests, or golf course staff
- Intentional club throwing or behaviour that could result in the damage of any player's equipment or golf course
- Failure to show consideration for others (For example, habitually not playing at a proper pace, intentionally distracting the play of another player, not playing by the USGA and established local rules, no-shows, giving advice on how a player should play, etc.)
- Consuming alcoholic beverages in an irresponsible manner which results in impairment or obvious intoxication

Proposed Disciplinary Actions to be Added to Standing Rules

First Offense- A written warning outlining the specific infraction will be sent to the offending member With a copy of the Code of Conduct and reference to the Standing Rule that outlines disciplinary action.

Second Offense- The member will receive written notice outline the specific infraction and will be notified of consecutive 4 week suspension from all AHGG affiliated activities.

Third Offence- The member will have their membership revoked and they will forfeit their membership fees.

The board will be the determining factor in disciplinary actions.
